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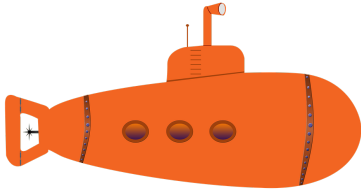

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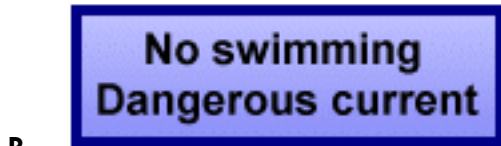

**The Good Old Days**

I was born in 1936 and I lived with my family in a village near Bristol. My father was a fruit farm advisor and my mother was a housewife. But when our teacher retired from my school, my mother asked for the school books and started a small school at home. I think about nine 1\_\_\_\_\_ used to come to study with us. Mother taught us French and English, even though she was very deaf!
