

write » writ ing ; argue » argu ing (a final -e is omitted)
put » put ting ; regret » regret ting ; readmit » readmit ting (we double the final
consonant if the verb ends in consonant-vowel-consonant, with the exception
of w, x and y, and only has one syllable or has the stress on the last syllable)
In the negative, not usually comes <u>before the gerund:</u>
